- **Large Moving Boxes** – Large boxes are the choice for light and medium weight but bulkier items like clothes, bedding, towels or other soft items.

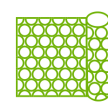
## Box Tips

- **Packing Paper** – Ideal for wrapping protection of packed items and filling small gaps to prevent shifting.

- **Foam Wrap** – Offers great protection during a move. We like to use it for glass, metal, and polished wood to keep items free of static, dust and scratches.
- **Corrugated Cardboard** – A great protector when a box doesn't work. Ideal for odd shapes or a secondary layer of protection for paintings and TV's after foam wrap.
- **Tape Dispenser** – An absolute essential to speed progress, keeping tape straight and flat on boxes and keeps your hands free of sticky tape.
- **Tape Rolls** – Get high quality tape for securing items and sealing boxes. Be sure to have a good supply during packing, and a few extra.
- **Box Cutter** – You'll thank us for this one when you start to unpack! Be sure to have blade refills, tape and cardboard will dull the blade pretty fast.
- **Permanent Markers** – An absolute necessity for marking boxes, special notes, directional arrows, warnings. Plus, it saves you from buying box labels.
- **Ropes & Cords** – An easy solution for many simple problems like keeping wardrobe doors closed or lists on chests.
